

DIRECTIONS FOR PRESENTATIONAL WRITING

Section One of this test consists of two presentational writing assignments. **The assignments can be found on the following pages.** You should use your time to plan, write, review, and edit your responses to the assignments.

Read each assignment carefully before you begin to write. Think about how you will organize your responses. **Your final response for each assignment must be written in the appropriate section of the answer document.**

Your responses to the presentational writing assignments will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria.

- **PURPOSE:** extent to which each assignment is addressed and is appropriate for the given audience and situation
- **COHERENCE:** clarity of the relationship among ideas
- **DEVELOPMENT:** extent to which ideas are elaborated and supported
- **GRAMMAR:** command of grammar and syntax
- **VOCABULARY:** appropriateness of word choice, command of idiomatic usage, and range of vocabulary
- **MECHANICS:** accuracy of spelling, character formation, diacritical marks, and punctuation

Your responses must be written in the target language.

Be sure to write about the assigned topics. Please write legibly. You may not use any reference materials during the test. Your written responses must be your original work, written in your own words, and not copied or paraphrased from some other work. Remember to review what you have written and make any changes you think will improve your responses.
